Wetlands Mitigation Bank

Need mitigation credits for your project's wetland alterations? ... EnSafe can help.

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, in coordination with the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation and Interagency Review Team, has approved the final Mitigation Banking Instrument (MBI) for the sale of wetlands credits. EnSafe has completed requirements for the initial release of 20 percent of the 126.6 total bank credits, having planted over 54,000 native wetland trees and shrubs across the property. The credit release milestones are based on meeting designated ecological performance standards over a seven-year timeline.
